Muscat – The Sultanate of Oman

YOUR STAY IN MUSCAT - 3 NIGHTS

Muscat, Oman's port capital, sits on the Gulf of Oman surrounded by mountains and desert. With history dating back to antiquity, it mixes high-rises and upscale shopping malls with clifftop landmarks such as the 16th-century Portuguese forts, Al Jalali and Mirani, looming over Muscat Harbor. Its modern, marble-clad Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, with 50m dome and prodigious Persian carpet, can accommodate 20,000 people. The city has other numerous mosques including Ruwi Mosque, Saeed bin Taimoor and Zawawi Mosque also a few Shi'ite mosques also exist here.

Muscat has several museums for example Museum of Omani Heritage, National Museum of Oman. Recent projects include an opera house. One of the most notable new projects is the Oman National Museum. It is expected to be an architectural jewel along with the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque.

The rocky Western Al Hajar Mountains dominate the landscape of Muscat. The city lies on the Arabian Sea along the Gulf of Oman and is in the proximity of the strategic Straits of Hormuz. Low-lying white buildings typify most of Muscat's urban landscape, while the port-district of Muttrah, with its corniche and harbour, form the north-eastern periphery of the city. Muscat's economy is dominated by trade, petroleum, liquified natural gas and porting.

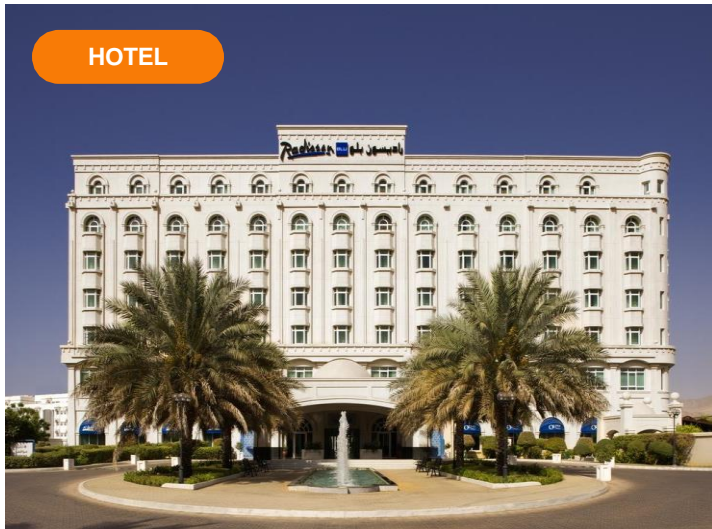

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR OMAN (FOR NATIONALITIES THAT APPLICABLE – USD 40 PER PASSPORT - Tourist (10 days)

- Clear passport copy (Scanned – Valid for minimum of 6 months)
- Photo (Scanned – Formal – white background).
- VISA charge is non-refundable once applied - visa issuance are subjected to Oman immigration approval.
- TOURIST VISA charges for (30 days) - USD 100 PER PASSPORT.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Cancellation policy will be advised prior to the travel confirmation and it will vary depend on the dates of travel.
